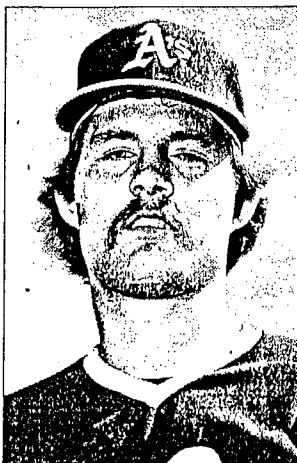


**No Justice:** You can make great cases for Andre Dawson, Bruce Sutter, Jim Rice and most certainly Bert Blyleven as Hall of Famers. What is hard to comprehend is Richard Justice's preference of Jack Morris over Blyleven.

Blyleven has 33 more career victories, 32 more shutouts and more than 1,200 more strikeouts. But perhaps the most glaring weakness in Morris' case is a shameful 5-3 loss on

May 3, 1980, to a pitcher he called asinine and pathetic — 20-game loser Brian Kingman of the Oakland A's.

Let it be remembered that Kingman remains 1-0 vs. would-be HOF candidate Morris.
